Congratulations! Your son has been recommended by his lacrosse coach for an opportunity to participate in an innovative college recruitment camp and game. Because of the potential he exhibits for competitive play at the collegiate level, his coach has chosen him to be a part of the **Southern Exposure Lacrosse Recruiting Camp**, which is being held at The Pavilion Recreation Complex in Taylors, South Carolina on June 26 & 27, 2009.

Two intensive practice sessions will be held: the first is on June 26<sup>th</sup> from 6:15 p.m. until 8:45 p.m., and the second is on June 27<sup>th</sup>, from 9:00 a.m. until 11:30 a.m., with the All-Star Game for all participants being played on June 27, 2009 under the lights at the recreation complex. College coaches from Division I, II, and III schools have been invited to take part in this recruitment camp, which is a tremendous opportunity for your son to be seen in a game situation.

This aspect of transitioning to college can be confusing and overwhelming. It is the goal of Southern Exposure Lacrosse Recruiting Camp to afford your son not only the opportunity to participate in sessions offering the best possible advanced drills and playing experience, but also the chance for you and your son to gain insights into the overall college recruitment process, including NCAA procedures and regulations regarding recruitment. A seminar will be held on Saturday, June 27, 2009, from 11:45 a.m. until 12:30 p.m., inside the Pavilion Building at the Complex.

This year we are working to incorporate a "College Row" activity into the schedule on June 27, 2009, from 12:30 p.m. until 2:00 p.m., also inside the Pavilion Building at the Complex, allowing you and your son the time to meet with representatives from area colleges to get information about post-secondary opportunities that are available in the area.
